NOSE: FRESH PINEAPPLE WITH BURSTS OF CITRUS COMBINE INITIALLY, FOLLOWED BY A HINT OF RICH VANILLA. RIPE PEAR AND RED APPLE AROMAS DEVELOP ALONGSIDE LIGHT WHITE CHOCOLATE.

TASTE: MOUTH-WARMING CHILLI SPICE IS FOLLOWED BY SMOOTH TROPICAL FRUIT FLAVOURS WITH A HINT OF MALTED CEREAL. AN UNDERTONE OF BLACK TREACLE DEVELOPS, LEADING TO ROASTED CASHEW NUT AND DRY OAK.

FINISH: A SHORT AND SWEET FINISH WITH RICH AND SMOOTH CARAMEL.
