COLOUR: GOLDEN.

NOSE: RICH DARK CHOCOLATE AND CREAMY FUDGE AROMAS ARE COMPLEMENTED BY SUBTLE CINNAMON SPICE. ORANGE OIL DEVELOPS ALONGSIDE BROWN SUGAR AND SWEET STRAWBERRY JAM.

TASTE: FRUITCAKE FLAVOURS WITH A HINT OF PRALINE LEADS TO AN UNDERTONE OF FRESH CHILLI. STEWED RAISIN SLOWLY TRANSFORMS INTO FRESH RASPBERRY COMPOTE WITH A SLIGHT MATURE OAK EDGE.

FINISH: A LONG FINISH WITH LINGERING MILK CHOCOLATE AND SUBTLE DRIED TOBACCO.
