**COLOUR:** LIGHTEST GOLD.

**NOSE:** TART **GREEN APPLE** AROMAS WITH FRESH NOTES OF **PINEAPPLE** ACCOMPANIES SWEET **BUTTERSCOTCH**. RIPE **BANANA** AND **LEMON ZEST** GIVE WAY TO SUBTLE **SHERBET**.

**TASTE:** RICH **VANILLA** AND SWEET **HONEYDEW** MELON FLAVOURS LEAD TO A SUBTLE HINT OF **TOASTED OAK**. JUICY **POACHED PEAR** NOTES COME TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE AN UNDERTONE OF **CRACKED BLACK PEPPER**.

**FINISH:** SHORT AND SLIGHTLY DRYING WITH TART **KIWI**; **BLACK PEPPER** LINGERS ON THE FINISH.
