NOSE: ZESTY *CITRUS* AND RICH *VANILLA POD* LEAD TO SOFT *MARZIPAN*. *POACHED PEAR* NOTES DEVELOP ALONGSIDE FRESH *APPLES* AND *MALTED CEREAL*.

TASTE: SWEET *HONEYDEW* MELON AND *PINEAPPLE* ARE BALANCED BY *WHITE PEPPER*. ROASTED MIXED *NUT* FLAVOURS GIVE WAY TO SOFT *HERBAL* NOTES.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH LINGERING *FRUIT* AND *SPICE*.
