COLOUR: DARK GOLD.

NOSE: FESTIVE *SPICE* AND RICH *FRUITCAKE* COMBINE WITH A HINT OF *CITRUS*. *COCOA POWDER* DEVELOPS ACCOMPANIED BY *DARK HONEY*.

TASTE: STEWED *RED BERRIES* AND SMOOTH *ORANGEZEST* INTERTWINE WITH *NUTMEG SPICE*. A HINT OF *DARK CHOCOLATE* AND *MALTED BISCUIT* BALANCES SOFT *HERBAL* NOTES.

FINISH: A LIGHT TO MEDIUM FINISH WITH LINGERING *ROASTED NUTS* AND *MATURE OAK*.
