**TASTE:** STEWED RED BERRIES AND SMOOTH ORANGEZEST INTERTWINE WITH NUTMEG SPICE. A HINT OF DARK CHOCOLATE AND MALTED BISCUIT BALANCES SOFT HERBAL NOTES.

**FINISH:** A LIGHT TO MEDIUM FINISH WITH LINGERING ROASTED NUTS AND MATURE OAK.
