TASTE: SMOOTH FLAVOURS OF HONEY AND SUBTLE WHITE PEPPER ARE FOLLOWED BY TOASTED ALMONDS.
WHITE CHOCOLATE AND LIME ZEST GIVE WAY TO A HINT OF GRAPEFRUIT.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED AND LONG FINISH WITH LINGERING SPICE AND MATURE OAK. DISTILLERY
