TASTE: COCOA POWDER AND BROWN SUGAR ARE BALANCED BY BLACK PEPPER. GRAPEFRUIT ZEST DEVELOPS ACCOMPANIED BY TREACLE TOFFEE AND ROASTED COFFEE BEANS.

FINISH: A FULL FINISH WITH LINGERING TOASTED ALMONDS, MATURE OAK AND SOFT SPICE.
