**TASTE:** SWEET AND SMOOTH FLAVOURS OF FESTIVE **SPICE** AND **MILK CHOCOLATE**. UNDERTONES OF **DRIED BANANA** DEVELOP WITH **ORANGE MARMALADE** AND **BUTTERSCOTCH**.

**FINISH:** A MEDIUM FINISH WITH **TOASTED ALMONDS** AND LINGERING **CINNAMON**.
