**COLOUR:** DARK GOLD.

**NOSE:** AROMAS OF **LEMON PEEL** AND POACHED **PEARS** GIVE WAY TO **ORANGE MARMALADE**. **VANILLA POD** COMES TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE **RED APPLE** AND SOFT **CHARRED OAK**.

**TASTE:** RICH **CITRUS ZEST** AND SOFT **BANANA** NOTES COMPLEMENT SWEET **HONEY**. **TOASTED HAZELNUTS** DEVELOP, ACCOMPANIED BY **MILK CHOCOLATE** AND **BROWN SUGAR**.

**FINISH:** A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH LINGERING NOTES OF BAKED **APPLES**, SUBTLE **WHITE PEPPER** AND **MATURE OAK**.
