NOSE: AROMAS OF LEMONPEEL AND POACHED PEARS GIVE WAY TO ORANGE MARMALADE. VANILLA POD COMES TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE RED APPLE AND SOFT CHARRED OAK.

TASTE: RICH CITRUS ZEST AND SOFT BANANA NOTES COMPLEMENT SWEET HONEY. TOASTED HAZELNUTS DEVELOP, ACCOMPANIED BY MILK CHOCOLATE AND BROWN SUGAR.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH LINGERING NOTES OF BAKED APPLES, SUBTLE WHITE PEPPER AND MATURE OAK.
