TASTE: SMOOTH AND SMOKY; BLACK PEPPER GIVES WAY TO MIXED NUTS AND COCOA POWDER. SUBTLE CITRUS NOTES COMBINE WITH TOASTED ALMONDS AND RED BERRIES.

FINISH: A LONG AND ASHY FINISH WITH LINGERING BONFIRE EMBERS.
