NOSE: SWEET POACHED PEAR AND PASSION FRUIT COMBINE WITH FAINT NOTES OF GRASS. HONEYSUCKLE NOTES COME TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE SOFT LEMON SHERBET AND TOASTED OAK.

TASTE: SMOOTH TROPICAL FRUITS GIVE WAY TO MIXED NUTS AND DARK HONEY. SUBTLE DESICCATED COCONUT LEADS TO A HINT OF ROSE WATER AND WHITE PEPPER.

FINISH: MEDIUM-BODIED WITH CITRUS ZEST.
